

# ÅLAND

THE ÅLAND ISLANDS IS a widespread archipelago with thousands of islands in the middle of the brackish Baltic Sea. Here the chances of catching sea trout are high mostly because over 200.000 smolt are being stocked to the population yearly in the many different fishing areas. This is being done to help keep the threatened wild population healthy. Most fishing is catch and release but naturally you are allowed to keep a nice trout for dinner. The season for fishing sea trout around Åland is when the water is cold so normally from October-May if the sea doesn't freeze.



# BOHUSLÄN

THE FJORDS OF BOHUSLÄN along the Swedish west coast north of Gothenburg is an archipelago made up of 7500 islands, small and large. This vast archipelago offers a varied and exciting fishing for sea trout. Hundreds of streams and rivers reach the ocean along the coast and these waterways are the lungs of the watercourse. In the autumn the sea trout move upstream to spawn. The fishing season is from the 1st of April until the 30th of September. In the meantime, all fishing for sea trout is closed so the fish can spawn and grow undisturbed. The area is self-sufficient with a wild population of sea trout and there are good regulations in place to secure a sustainable fishing.
